



COMPLETE BIO

Victoria Malenfant is a French vocalist based in Montreal. Born in Paris, she spent her childhood in France before moving to Los Angeles and then to Montreal where her family settled down. With her rich and sensitive voice, Victoria Malenfant explores the different styles that have influenced her, from classic French songs to jazz, but also from musicals to Brazilian music.

She discovered her love for the stage at a young age through theater and went on to continue through singing and music which she pursued on the side before going to school in music. She participated in the two musicals produced by her school, *Le chant de Saint-Carmen de la Main* (Daniel Bélanger) and *Company* (Stephen Sondheim), landing the lead role of this last one.

Influenced by the greatest singers, such as Édith Piaf, Ella Fitzgerald and Billie Holiday, she continued her studies in Jazz in university, while also performing in *Footloose* by Productions 90'. In September 2022, she won the first place of the Emerging Artist Contest of the Sutton Jazz Fest, and also co-composed the music for the circus and magic show *La Reine des Rats* by Productions Old Charlotte. She also gives private singing lessons, trains an afro-brazilian martial art, and works on her first album while performing regularly in Montreal.
